- 1- Accountability for \$ received from Coop by various groups.
- -At SAC meeting of Feb 16<sup>th</sup>, members voted that the 5 groups that have not provided some accountability of how they spent their funds not be granted further subsidizes unless they do so.
  - -SAC did not receive any funds in the calendar year of 2023 from HOA although some funds had been voted on for 2023 and distributed only in 2024.
  - SAC will request copy of any by-law presently existing within the various groups, probably only Men's group and Women's group so that we all can review any clauses regarding funds.
- 2- SAC 2023 Financial report (which will tabled at their annual meeting March 21<sup>st</sup>) will be provided to HOA Board members by mid march in order for HOA Board members to review these and discuss these at their March 28<sup>th</sup> meeting.
  - -Going forward Dave E will provide a receipt to any Treasurer or chair of groups when receiving money after events.
- 3- Sales tax and its applicability to various ticket sales by various groups was discussed. Since these small charges are seen as donations to SAC for expenses of various events, Ron and Randy will research the ramifications of the applicability of Donations within Florida tax laws. Meanwhile SAC will instruct various groups to print Donation beside ticket price starting now. HOA Board members and SAC members will be asked to discuss this and come to an agreement.
- 4- SAC plans for 2024.
  - -At their March meeting SAC members will be asked to confirm the \$4,000. Ceiling to the 4 major groups and Dave E will explain how that running subsidy will be accounted for,
  - -SAC will provide a 2024 budget to HOA by mid March for their discussion at the March 28<sup>th</sup> meeting.
  - -HOW to attract more newcomers to events was discussed. Ideas included a Bulk mailing, substantial door prizes at coffee, publicity

for the future FREE SATURDAY COFFEE events, a revamp of the Welcoming Committee approach, a HOA Spring or Fall FREE PICNIC/EVENT.

- -How to attract new Volunteers and provide appreciation for the present Volunteers was discussed. A annual FREE GET TOGETHER/ PARTY with significant prizes was discussed. Both SAC and the HOA will add these subjects to their respective meetings to come to some understanding as to what steps should be taken.
